To become a member you must fill out a membership application, pay your dues, and <u>attend one meeting before the Club votes on your</u> membership.

Should you become a BASIC member or a GOLD member? Here are some points about becoming a BASIC member:

- As a BASIC member, you do not have any work obligations to the club.
- As a BASIC member, you have no voting rights.
- As a BASIC member, you do not have the right to use the building except by prior appointment (48 hour notice) on Members' Night, Thursdays when there are no meetings, between 7PM and 9PM
- As a BASIC member, you only receive \$10 off of classes and a discount towards seminars.

Why become a GOLD member? Here are some points about becoming a GOLD Member:

- As a GOLD member, you have full voting rights, giving you a say in club decisions.
- As a GOLD member, you have full use of the building, with access to the keypad code for training and practice, once you have met the 15 hours of work service a year per adult member of the household (30 hours maximum).
- As a GOLD member, you receive 50% off classes, once work hours have been met.
- As a GOLD member, you are offered classes, seminars, and other club activities before they are offered to other members and to the public.
- As a GOLD member, you have the opportunity to join a training group to practice, or you may form your own group.
- As a GOLD member, you have full use of the club library.
- As a GOLD member, you have full use of all equipment.
