The Bay De Noc Kennel Club will be offering a **6 week BEGINNER NOSEWORK** class starting October 17th Thursday and running every Thursday at 7:00PM. Nosework is open to any dog/puppy from 12 weeks old to adult. Even dogs 10-12 years old can have fun learning nosework. Class is for an hour each week and will be held at the Bay De Noc Kennel Club building located by the Wells Sports Complex.

Nosework is the exciting new sport of teaching your dog to search and find a particular odor, the same way that drug dogs are trained to find narcotics. We start by teaching your dog to find the odor in a box and then graduate to your dog finding the odor in drawers, under toys, in chairs etc outside and on vehicles. This class is great for all kinds of dogs. If your dog is very shy it helps them develop confidence, if they are older or on restricted activity nosework is a great mental exercise, puppies learn nosework quickly and overly active dogs learn to concentrate.

Nosework is a great winter activity because it can be trained and practiced in your living room or basement. It's a great indoor and outdoor activity for you and your dog and a great bonding experience.

The fee for this 6 week course is \$90 for non members, \$50.00 for Gold members, and \$80 for Basic members. The only equipment needed is a leash, a wide quick release collar (not a buckle collar) and some exceptionally good soft treats cut in very small pieces. **You will need LOTS of treats**. If your dog loves a ball or toy more than treats please bring it. Please find the treats your dog LOVES!! Steak, roast beef, string cheese, liver (my dogs favorite). Don't rely on store bought stuff, unless that is the only thing your dog likes.

Each handler will be supplied with a jar of qtips with the odors. These are the odors used for scent work from novice thru elite. This is included in the class fee.

PRE-TRIAL IN ALL ELEMENTS 5 MINUTE TIME LIMIT-no distractions are used in pre-trial-only main scent used-no distractions

Master- interior -hides will be as follows

1. all hides in one area with no distractions and one distraction in a blank area (an area without a hide) or

2 all hides and one distraction in one area with no hides or distraction in a blank area (an area without a hide) or

3 one or two hides and one distraction in one area, and the additional hide(s) in the other area

Master Vehicle the distraction may be placed on the same vehicle as the hide but cannot be on the same side as the hide. The distraction can be placed on a vehicle next to the vehicle with the hide.

Elite-interior

1 the smaller space can contain no more than two items (hides and or distractions) in each space

2 the larger two spaces may contain no more than three items (hides and or distractions) in each space

Elite Vehicle –one distraction may be placed on the same vehicle as the hide but cannot be on the same side as the hide. A distraction may also be placed on a vehicle next to the vehicle with the hide.
