NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

*Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

*It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. If an exhibitor is asked to leave the trial site, then the exhibitor will not be refunded any fees that have been paid.

*Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

*Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Any illegible or incomplete entries will not be entered in the trial.

Additional Notices

Certification shall be received by the Trial Secretary (delivered by hand or sent by mail) not later than ten days following the close of the trial. No refunds will be made without a veterinarian's written certification.
- In the unfortunate occurrence of the death of an entered dog, entry fees will be refunded in full.
- Any dog that is ill or a possible carrier of any contagious disease shall not be on any club property or at any club event.



Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons.

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
