Membership can only be changed at the start of the Club's official year, September 1st.

RENEWAL GOLD MEMBERS

Gold Members in Good Standing that have not been able to complete their required 15 hours for whatever reason are allowed to pay \$20 per hour for any hour missed. This does not apply to initial New Gold Membership hours. Fees are due with the next year's membership dues, September 1, without penalty. If the Gold Member fails to pay the \$20 per hour fee on or before September 30 their membership is lapsed.

NEW MEMBERS

Prospective New Members will submit a membership application and their fee for the type of membership. If the membership application is submitted on or after March 1st, membership dues are half price. Prospective New Members will be contacted by a member of the Membership Committee to

help them become familiar with the requirements of the club. NEW GOLD Members will be assigned a Mentor if needed. A Mentor is a Gold Member in Good Standing, assigned by the membership committee who will help the new member sign up for a cleaning assignment and other work hours.

NEW GOLD Members have a year from the date that their application is approved to put in their <u>initial-year work hours</u> and will have the NEW GOLD Member benefits listed on the chart above until the requirements for the <u>initial-year work hours</u> are met. When a NEW GOLD Member has completed the <u>initial-year work hours</u> the NEW GOLD Member will have the benefits listed for a GOLD Member Renewal. If the <u>initial-year work hours</u> are not completed by the initial-year anniversary date, the NEW GOLD Member will be deleted from the membership roster and all benefits are canceled. The NEW GOLD Member may then apply to become a Gold or Basic Member but must start the entire process over with a new application, fees, and work hours.

There are separate requirements for club-year work hours and initial-year work hours. The Membership Committee will compile the <u>initial-year work hours</u> separately from the normal <u>club-year</u> work hours.

Re the Standing Rules:

PRACTICE GROUPS - BUILDING and LAND USAGE FEES:

Gold Members: \$10 for up to two (2) hours maximum.

Gold Member Teachers: Free (Must have taught a minimum of 2-6 week classes, 3-4 week classes, or 6 Clinics/Games/Run Throughs per year)

Gold Member Helper with Classes (up to two people per class): \$5.00 up to two (2) hours Maximum. (Must have helped with 2-6 week classes, 3-4 week classes, or 6 Clinics/Games/Run Throughs per year)

REINSTATEMENT OF LAPSED MEMBERSHIP: A person can be reinstated to Gold Member status by:

- Paying \$20 for each hour of the fifteen minimum hours that has not been met.
- Paying \$50 for any cleaning obligation that has been missed.
- Paying a re-instatement fee of \$50
