$\checkmark$ Access to classes, seminars, and other club activities
$\checkmark$ Opportunity to join or form a training/practice group to practice with others
$\checkmark$ Full use of all equipment and resources (must first be trained on the equipment i.e. agility)

## BASIC MEMBERSHIP

To become a Basic Member you must fill out a membership application, your application will be read at two meeting, attend one meeting before the club votes on your membership, pay appropriate dues. There are no required volunteer hours. You have no voting rights. You will have $\$ 10$ off of classes and a discount toward seminars.

## JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

To become a Junior Member you must be under the age of 18 , fill out a membership application, attend one meeting before the club votes on your membership, pay appropriate dues. There are no required volunteer hours and you have no voting rights. You will have \$10 off of classes and a discount toward seminars.
